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## **Summer League Match Night Format**

League games will consist of playing three games of pairs each playing 3 legs, with one point being awarded for each leg won (9 points available in total).

On each match night, in addition to playing the 3 league games, an additional 'friendly'  $4^{th}$  game will be played. This  $4^{th}$  game will be 3 legs and will take the 'losing crib' format, the results of which will form a separate league table. One point will be awarded for each leg won (3 points available in total). Pairs nominated to play in this game should play in either the  $1^{st}$  or  $2^{nd}$  league game so that the 'losing' game can be played at about the same time as the  $3^{rd}$  league game.

The rules of 'losing crib' are much the same as normal league crib with the following exceptions.

- The aim of 'losing crib' is to lose the game (so, for example keep low hands and 'load' the opponents box).
- The loser is the team to peg 61 holes first (i.e. only once around the board).
- When cutting for the 'box' the highest card wins the box (picture cards all count as 10 as per normal league crib.).
- Cutting a Jack at the beginning of a hand counts 2 holes to the opposition.
- The losing pair will score 1 point for each of the 3 legs played, so 3 points are available to win.

At the end of the season a play-off will take place in both 'normal' and 'losing' crib whereby the winner of League 1 plays the runner-up of League 2 and the winner of League 2 plays the runner-up of League 1. The two 'winners' then play each other to determine the overall winner and runner-up (this assumes that sufficient teams register to allow two leagues). A trophy will be presented to the winners of both 'normal' and 'losing' crib.
